

- a. MIAA restructuring its committees. One official and one coach from each district. Currently, Jeff Wyman represents us. If there is anyone interested in this new committee, we will submit them? EBoard Members can submit additional nominees using this link: <u>https://www.formstack.com/forms/?6027366-QSdKyNJtJd</u>. Nominations close on January 31, 2025. Not all nominees will be automatically selected.
- b. We currently have 71 people who are registered in Arbiter and attached to our association, but only 59 dues paid members.
- c. Indoor Track: same format, invitational format. Schools will rotate sites. Guidance on participation limits remain the same: unlimited in 55, 55H, 1000, mile, 2 mile; 6 in 300, 600, HJ, SP; B relays allowed. Flip flop each week who throws and jumps first. Rotational throwers will throw first, prior to any events on the track, and separate from other throwers.
- d. Spring: dual meet schedules should be out by the end of January. Look for a questionnaire from Pete as early as next week. You can go in and make date blocks now in Arbiter. Venues relative to vault and high jump: Officials must ensure it is safe before competition.
